**Join us this year for North Coast Open Studios Art Night, Friday, May 31, from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m.** A listing of participating artists and Art Night-specific maps are on **pages 4-6**.

**North Coast Open Studios** is an annual showcase of local artists and their art in Humboldt County. Included in this guide, you will find listings for artists who are opening their studios (their “natural habitats,” if you will) to the public, allowing art lovers a glimpse into the creative process.

Visitors to **North Coast Open Studios** will have an opportunity to see what happens inside an artist’s creative space. Meet the artists and see work from a wide array of art styles, including painting, photography, printmaking, sculpture, glass, fiber, jewelry, ceramics, and more. During this free showcase for the arts, visit mid-career and emerging artists in traditional and non-traditional spaces. Talk to artists about their creative process, see their recent works, and purchase art.

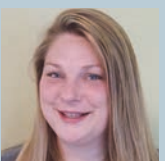
**Amy Fowler** is the owner of the online millinery supply business Humboldt Haberdashery and her bespoke millinery is

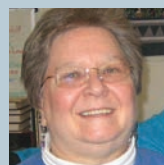
**Larissa Haney** actually trained to be a botanist, but found art as a hobby and later a business when a health problem forced her to
